## Welcome to Week 31 Of Our Newsletter

#### From The Pastor...

Praying that you have had a blessed week and that God is supplying all your needs.

Once again, this Sunday past, our Safety and Security Team met in the church sanctuary to implement the preparations necessary based on the previous meeting.

During the meeting it was realized that the original October 25th target date would not be achievable based on the time frame involved in acquiring our disinfectant fogger and the need to "deep clean" the church prior to the first Sunday opening. We are now hoping that November 1st will be our reopening date. Again, this is a goal and a definitive announcement will be made.

While most of the protocols were listed in the previous newsletter, there was some "fine tuning" that came out of Sunday's meeting:

-Temperature taken upon entry to the church facility. Anyone exceeding 100 degrees Fahrenheit or above (surface reading) will be asked to return home. Likewise, anyone who has been in close contact with anyone demonstrating any flu like symptoms would be discouraged from entering.

-Social distancing will be in force with no more than three individuals per pew, with the exception of family grouping. As we must also space occupied pews with an empty pew, seating will be limited. Overflow seating will be in the two side (classroom) areas of the sanctuary. Those attending will be asked to wait to be seated by members of the Safety and Security Team in order that we might maximize available seating most efficiently. The Safety and Security Team has developed a seating strategy that will enhance social distancing. Please be patient as we work through these efforts for everyone's health and safety.

- -No singing will be included in the initial services.
- -A limit of one person in the restroom at a time (exception for parent/child or other family relationship).

Please keep this entire process in your urgent prayers. While we are doing all we can to move towards reopening our church facilities, we are concerned about doing so in the face of once again increasing numbers of COVID 19 cases.

-When we do resume services, a recording will continue to be provided on YouTube for those in the "high risk" category who may not be able to attend the live service. We will also continue to provide the "Cross-Currents" Newsletter as a bulletin will not be published for the live service for the time being.
